#### **Location and Accommodations**

The Sheraton Sand Key Resort on Clearwater Beach has been described as: "The best of both worlds — a spectacular secluded beach tucked conveniently close to Florida's exciting attractions."

The conference schedule includes plenty of time to enjoy the sun and surroundings. Enjoy the outdoor pools, fitness center, and tennis courts, or simply stroll the white sandy beaches. Beach activities — Sand Key Park's nature trails and surf-ready beaches — are steps away.
